

Growth Mindset for Coaches

During sessions:

Give yourself time to get to know your student's habits, strengths, and challenges.

Keep an open mind if you're having trouble downloading lessons or navigating Zoom. Your tech skills will improve with practice!

If you make a mistake during a lesson, use it as an opportunity to talk about how it's okay to get things wrong at first.

Pay attention to how your Reading Specialist models the lessons and ask for guidance if you are unsure.

Outside of sessions:

Ask your Reading Specialist for feedback or debrief your sessions with them. Take notes and make goals for yourself!

Avoid fixed mindset statements like "I can't get my student to pay attention," "My student always struggles with long vowels," or "I don't understand Zoom."
